Kovalainen to partner Hamilton at McLaren for 2008

McLaren have confirmed that Heikki Kovalainen is to become Lewis Hamilton's team mate for the 2008 season. Spaniard Pedro de la Rosa will remain as McLaren's third driver, while Gary Paffett will assist with the team's testing programme when required.

Kovalainen made his Formula One race debut with Renault at the start of this season, but lost his seat earlier this week when the French squad announced Fernando Alonso and Nelson Piquet Jr as their 2008 drivers. The 26-year-old Finn joins his new...

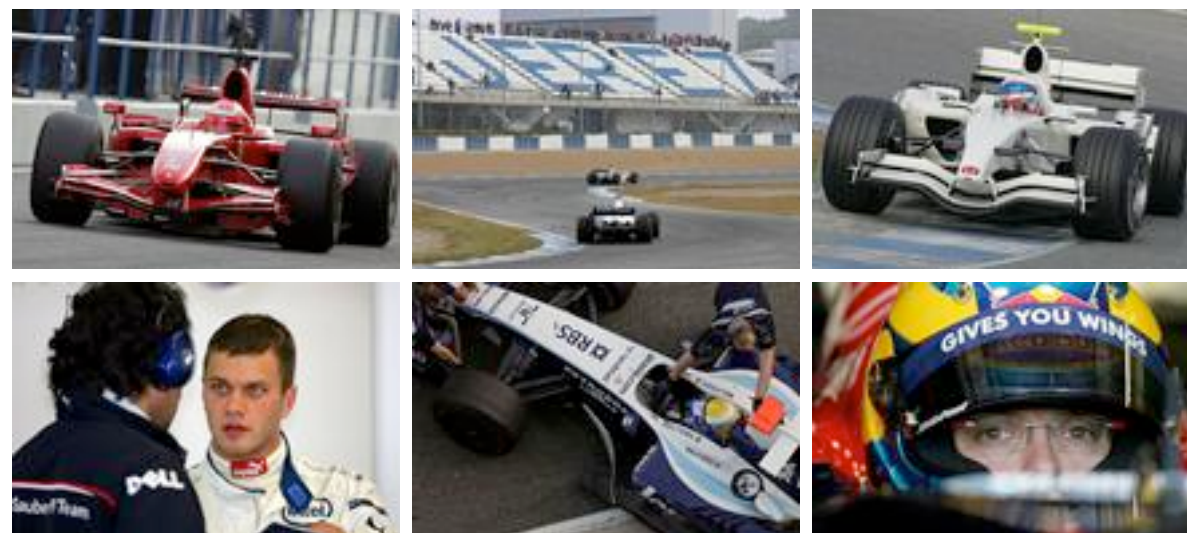
